





# **METRO ROME**





- **1. Hotel Voi Donna Camilla Savelli** Via Garibaldi 27, 00153 Rome, Italy
- **2. Colosseum -** the largest amphitheatre built during the Roman Empire.
- 3. Spanish Steps as one of the great masterpieces of baroque urban design, Rome's most iconic staircase has been a meeting place for artists and poets, lovers and layabouts for nearly three centuries.
- **4. Trevi Fountain -** the most beautiful fountain in Rome.
- Pantheon a temple so well preserved that it has hardly changed its appearance since the days of the Roman Empire.

- **6. Piazza Navona** Rome's most famous square is a gorgeous baroque treasure, lined with cafés and restaurants.
- 7. St. Peter's Church & Vatican City -St. Peter's Basilica is one of the holiest temples in Christianity and one of the largest churches in the world. Vatican City is the headquarters of the Roman Catholic Church and the smallest country in the world.
- 8. Campo di Fiori during the day, the piazza is home to one of Rome's many food markets. In the evenings, it transforms, attracting tourists and locals to its restaurants and bars. It's a lively hub for socialising and shopping.

#### **Public Transportation**

#### Nearest bus stop to the hotel:

Lgt Farnesina / Trilussa: Bus numbers 23, 280 and n3s (night bus) stop here, approx. 7 minutes on foot

#### Nearest tram to the hotel:

Trastevere (Mastai): tram number 8 stops here, the distance from the hotel is around 12 minutes on foot

**Subway (Metro):** is not available near the hotel

Nearest taxi stand: Piazza Trilussa, approx. 7 minutes on foot

#### Tickets:

Tickets for public transport can be bought in the local tobacco shops "Tabacchi". Cost: € 1.50 per person. The tickets are network tickets for buses, trams and subway trains (Metro), each valid for 75 minutes in one direction of travel incl. changes. You cannot buy tickets directly on the buses, trams or subway trains.


### You will be staying in beautiful downtown Rome, in Rome's oldest historical district - Trastevere
